How to make online and in-person deposits into your child's CollegeBound savings account

We're so glad you're interested in making a deposit into your child's CollegeBound savings account! Please keep in mind, you will earn interest only on the deposits you or your family and friends make into the account; if you do not want to earn interest, please contact CollegeBound support staff or submit the Interest-Opt Out form found in your Welcome Kit. Online Deposits

- By direct deposit: Automatically deposit funds from your paycheck into your child's savings account. Most employers have options for splitting your paycheck; ask your employer for a direct deposit form.
- Online Bill Pay (ACH): If you have a personal checking or savings account, you can make a deposit using Online Bill Pay or an external transfer from your bank or credit union. You can choose whether you want to make a one-time or recurring payment. If you need assistance setting this up, please contact your financial institution.
- **Wire Transfer:** Wire funds from an existing account at another institution to your child's savings account. Fees may apply. Simply provide your child's name, address, Bremer's routing number found above and the CollegeBound account number.
- **Split your tax refund:** When filing your taxes, you can direct deposit your refund into up to three accounts. Enter the information about your child's CollegeBound account and how much you want to deposit when choosing how you'd like to receive your refund. By splitting your refund, you get the convince of sending your money where you want it the first time instead of moving it out of your checking or savings account later.



In-Person Deposits

 In person: Make a deposit at any Bremer Bank location. Bring your deposit (cash, check, or money order) and your child's account number with you.
